BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers across Missouri play a vital role in ensuring the safety and security of all roadway users through diligent traffic enforcement, education, and crash prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, traffic crashes remain a leading cause of injury and death in Missouri, and collaborative initiatives between law enforcement agencies and public safety partners are essential to reducing fatalities and serious injuries on our roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Traffic Safety Advisory Council (LETSAAC) provides critical training, resources, and a unified voice for law enforcement professionals committed to advancing traffic safety throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the annual LETSAAC Conference serves as a statewide forum for sharing best practices, innovative enforcement strategies, and life-saving technologies that enhance the effectiveness of traffic safety initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Law Enforcement Traffic Safety Week, observed during the LETSAAC Conference from July 21 through July 25, 2025, recognizes and honors the dedication of Missouri's law enforcement officers to saving lives and protecting communities on our highways and streets; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting to encourage all citizens, agencies, and public safety stakeholders to support traffic safety efforts and to thank those who serve on the front lines of enforcement and education.
