

## STATE OF MISSOURI *Proclamation* BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, on December 5, 1994, Lee M. Kraus began his public service career as an EMT-B with St. Louis Emergency Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 1998, Kraus joined the St. Louis Fire Department as a firefighter; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Kraus honorably served the department for more than 27 years before suffering a medical emergency in the line of duty on June 29, 2025, and being transported to a hospital in cardiac arrest, where he died on July 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, firefighters courageously and selflessly devote their lives to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of their fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Missouri are thankful for the sacrifices of the brave emergency responders who risk their own lives to protect the lives and property of their fellow citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MIKE KEHOE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, as a mark of respect for the death of

and for his bravery and service to the St. Louis Fire Department and the citizens of St. Louis do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of Missouri shall be flown at half-staff at every fire station in the State of Missouri and at the Fire Fighters Memorial, located in Kingdom City, Missouri, and at all government buildings in the independent City of St. Louis from sunrise until sunset on July 9, 2025.
